## Arizona State Permitting Dashboard Project Criteria

The Arizona State Permitting Dashboard provides a single location for owners of large, complex infrastructure projects to track the progress of each permit. It is a voluntary system, and only projects submitted through the State Permitting Dashboard site will be considered for publication on the dashboard.

To be eligible for the dashboard, a project must meet the following criteria.

- 1. Involve infrastructure construction for one the following sectors:
  - Aviation
  - Broadband
  - Electricity transmission
  - Land revitalization
  - Manufacturing
  - Mining
  - Pipelines
  - Renewable or conventional energy production
  - Surface transportation
  - Wastewater
  - Water resource
- 2. Be subject to applicable state environmental laws, permitting regulations and other relevant government authorizations, the size and complexity of which will make the eligible project benefit from enhanced oversight and coordination.
- 3. Require a total construction investment of more than \$25,000,000. If the total construction investment is less than \$25,000,000, an agency director may find that other factors make enhanced oversight and coordination beneficial to the eligible project.
