Achieving Better Outcomes with Released Young Offenders

The Department of Juvenile Corrections recognizes that youth released from secured care are much more likely to avoid committing new delinquent offenses if they are productively engaged in school or work when released back into the community. For this reason, the department set a new target of **79% engagement, 12 points above the existing 67% score** as of January 2016. Using tools and methods of the Arizona Management System to track performance and resolve sticking points, the department was able to achieve and sustain 82% engagement for four consecutive months ending February 2017.
