Office Space Consolidation Saves State \$600K in Annual Rent Expense

The Department of Environmental Quality significantly changed its office layout and overall footprint in 2016, vacating about 30,000 square feet at its Capitol Mall headquarters and an entire building previously used by the agency's Vehicle Emissions Inspection program. The changes are **saving the State approximately \$600,000** in annual rent and sale of the VEI property **returned nearly \$1.9M to the General Fund**. Other agencies are now renting the freed up space at headquarters, which has created additional savings for the State.
