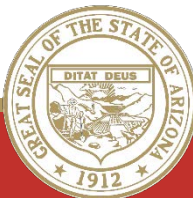

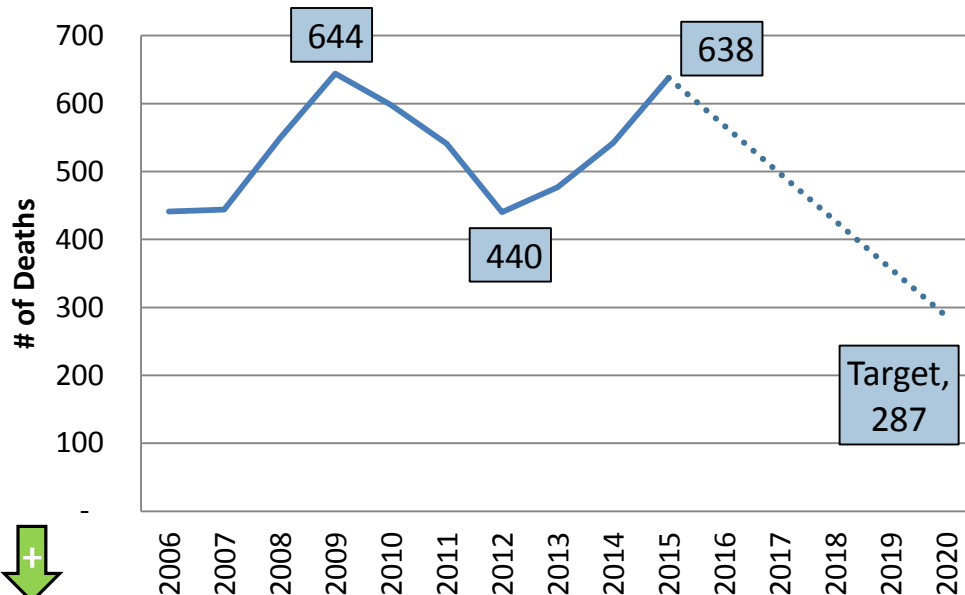

### Activity Updates:

- Submitted coordinated SAMHSA application requesting ~\$12 million for Arizona activities
- AZPOST Naloxone training for Law Enforcement is live
- Executive order for quantity limits goes live April 1, 2017
- AHCCCS E-prescribing data runs & marketing plan in development
- HB 2493 (Drug Overdose Fatality Review Team) passed House
- Discharge Guidelines Planning Summit to be held March 29<sup>th</sup>
- Rethink Rx Abuse Campaign Implemented
- High School Health & Wellness Grant Program RFGA issued

### Challenges

- No Good Samaritan Law in AZ
- Funding options for initial and replacement Naloxone kits for law enforcement
- Additional assistance is needed to spread the word
